



WHAT ARE THE TOURNAMENT DATES? Wednesday, July 14 through Sunday, July 18, 2010 – five days

HOW MANY CHIPS DO TOURNAMENTS START WITH? All tournaments start with **5,000 in chips**. Blinds, limits, antes always progress at a very moderate pace, and rounds are 30 minutes

HOW MUCH ARE SINGLE-TABLE SATELLITES? A variety of buy-ins, but generally: **\$25, \$30, etc.**

HOW MANY CHIPS IN SATELLITES? **2,500** and only \$3 house entry fee

SINGLE-TABLE SATELLITE TIMES: Twice daily: 7:00 AM-10:30 AM & 4:00 PM -12:30AM

CAN I SIGN UP OVER THE PHONE OR SEND YOU A CHECK? Signups are in-person only. However, you can have someone else sign you up. A cash machine is available nearby on the casino floor and check cashing at the cage.

CAN I SIGN UP FOR MORE THAN ONE TOURNAMENT AT A TIME? Yes, if you do you won't need to worry about being stuck in any lines. Otherwise, you should sign up as early as possible on the day of the tournament

SIGN-UP SCHEDULE: Starts Tuesday, July 13th from 12 noon to 8 PM; then Wednesday July 14th until Sunday, July 18th: from 9 AM to 9 PM, daily

WHAT TIME DO EVENTS START? All start at noon

WHAT IF I DRIVE ALL THAT WAY AND YOU ARE SOLD OUT? If you make the effort to get here we will make the effort to find a way that you get to play, and we never shut anyone out who is here on time. We can handle 720 players. If more, we will make alternates

WHAT IF I SIGN UP FOR A TOURNAMENT AND THEN WIN A SATELLITE? You can either sell the satellite winner receipt to another player, or get your buy-in back, but from the tournament cashier, only. Satellites never return cash

HOW MANY PLACES DO YOU PAY? Roughly, 9% of the field, 54 players, maximum

HOW LONG DO THE ONE-DAY TOURNAMENTS LAST? All tournaments are one-day events and require about 12 hours in terms of actual length of time, but that includes regular breaks and an hour dinner break. Normally ten hours playing time

HOW MANY LIVE ACTION GAMES DO YOU USUALLY GET? We can accommodate up to 28 live tables. Realistically, we fill them all on weekends. Smallest limits are \$4-\$8; but we spread many more from \$10-\$20 through \$30-\$60; Omaha at \$4-8 and \$10-\$20; pot limit and no limit with various blinds and buy-ins

CRUISES: Wildhorse will award fourteen 7-day Mexican Rivera Poker Cruises for two people, hosted by "Card player cruises" on Royal Caribbean Line's *Mariner*. One cruise will be awarded to each & every poker tournament winner.

GOLF: Wildhorse has a championship course. Bring your clubs. The weather is always perfect in July. Poker players get a \$20 green fee!
