**POKER ROUND-UP**

The Poker Round-Ups at Wildhorse Resort Casino are held twice each year, April and November, and they are well-established and dominate the tournament poker world of the greater Pacific Northwest, including Oregon, Washington, Montana, Idaho, and Northern Nevada.

Since the 2005 Spring PRU, total Prize money always tops \$1,000,000. There are 13 events during each of the 12-day Poker Round-Ups.

One of the main features of any Poker Round-Up is added money, usually around \$75,000. Another great feature is low buy-ins of \$200 to \$500. And a further example of player-friendliness is the entry fees, which are always only \$15 – *never higher!*

Average total attendance just under 4,500; or about 345 players per event, including the relatively low-attendance in the Ladies and Seniors events.

The Round-Ups are first-class poker tournaments, which is why they remain well-attended even during the recent economic downturn.

Wildhorse's success and great reputation can be attributed to many things: friendly and helpful employees, willingness to cater to poker players down to the smallest details, and the overall atmosphere of fun. And, of course, there is the money. Players not only receive great prize money for low buy-ins, every winner is currently awarded a multi-day poker cruise for two.

Even though our main market is Pacific Northwest, players come to Wildhorse from as far away as New York, Florida, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Michigan and quite a few states in between.

Many highly accomplished poker pros attend Wildhorse events. To name a few: Tom McEvoy, Susie Isaacs, Oklahoma Johnny Hale, Marsha Waggoner, Howard "Tahoe" Andrew, Vince Burgio, Linda Johnson, and Barbara Enright.

Oh yes, there is one rule: Fun is required!
