**SUMMER POKER RODEO**

**SINGLE-TABLE EXPANDED SATELLITE SCHEDULE:** Twice daily: 7:00 AM-10:00 AM; and 4:00 PM until midnight. Satellite schedule starts at 6:00 PM Tuesday afternoon July 14<sup>th</sup>. Due to player demand, we have expanded and improved our satellite program. Buy-ins are \$49 and the top three finishers all receive a \$150 voucher good for buy-ins to any 2009 Summer Poker Rodeo event or satellite.

**HOW MANY CHIPS DO YOU START WITH?** Blinds, limits, antes always progress at a very moderate pace, and rounds are 30 minutes. 3,000 in starting chips.

**CAN I SIGN UP OVER THE PHONE OR SEND YOU A CHECK?** Signups are in-person only. But, you can have someone else sign you up. A cash machine is available nearby on the casino floor. Check cashing at the cage.

**CAN I SIGN UP FOR MORE THAN ONE TOURNAMENT AT A TIME?** Yes, if you do you won't need to worry about being stuck in any lines. Otherwise, you should sign up as early as possible on the day of the tournament.

**SIGN-UP SCHEDULE:** Start Tuesday, July 14 from 1 PM to 9 PM; then July 15-19: 9 AM to 9 PM

**WHAT TIME DO EVENTS START?** All events start at noon


**WHAT IF I DRIVE ALL THAT WAY AND YOU ARE SOLD OUT?** If you make the effort to get here we will make the effort to find a way that you get to play, and we never shut anyone out who is here on time. We can handle 720 players on 10-handed tables. Even if there are more than 720 players, we will make alternates.

**WHAT IF I SIGN UP FOR A TOURNAMENT AND THEN WIN A SATELLITE?** You can either sell the satellite winner receipt to another player, or get your buy-in back, but from the tournament cashier, only. Satellites never return cash.

**HOW MANY PLACES DO YOU PAY?** Roughly, 9% of the field, with a maximum of six tables paid.

**HOW LONG DO THE ONE-DAY TOURNAMENTS LAST?** Like most other major one-day tournaments, around 12 hours in terms of actual length, but that includes regular breaks as well as an hour dinner break. 10 hours of playing time is normal.

**HOW MANY LIVE ACTION GAMES DO YOU USUALLY GET?** Lots. We can accommodate up to 32 live tables. Realistically, we fill about 20 for the Summer Rodeo. Smallest limits are \$4-\$8; but we spread many more from \$10-\$20 through \$30-\$60; Omaha at \$4-8 and \$10-\$20; pot limit and no limit with buy-ins of \$400 and \$1,000.

 **CRUISES:** Wildhorse will award 5 Mexican Rivera Cruises on the *Royal Caribbean Line's Mariner of the Seas*. Card Player Cruises is the host for the cruise. One cruise will be awarded to each poker tournament winner. Cruise departs and returns at Los Angeles, CA. Winners are responsible for their own travel to and from Los Angeles.
