**Wildhorse Resort & Casino to open four new food  
and beverage venues and second non-smoking slots floor**

Outstanding food and great entertainment are on the menu for Wildhorse Resort & Casino with the upcoming opening in late April of two new restaurants, a cabaret and a lounge.

Altogether the resort is spending nearly \$15 million to bring new excitement to what is already Eastern Oregon's prime entertainment venue. *Traditions*, a buffet restaurant with an open hearth grill and chef's cooking display, will join *Plateau*, a fine dining experience that will offer not only terrific food but also marvelous views of the nearby Blue Mountains.

Across from *Traditions*, guests will now find *Players* and *Wildfire*. The first, a lounge, will offer a merging of relaxation and sports entertainment on the many TV screens every day of the year. Adjacent to the lounge, Wildfire Cabaret will host live entertainment Thursday through Friday every week, with the best of West Coast blues, rock and roll and soul, on stage and live. Musical acts from the Pacific Northwest, Nevada and California are signed up to provide Eastern Oregon with live music for listening and dancing.

The casino will also add more gaming fun, with new slot machine games from the world's top game manufacturers, nearly 40 new games and 140 new machines to bring the total slots at Wildhorse to over 800. The new slots area, adjacent to the restaurants and cabaret, will be

entirely non-smoking, as will be the restaurants and cabaret. Smoking will be allowed in the lounge.

Wildhorse Resort & Casino is the Pacific Northwest's highest paying casino, with a record \$9.3 million slot jackpot. The Resort includes a 24-hour casino, hotel, RV Park, 18-hole golf course and Tribal museum. It is located just minutes off I-84 at Exit 216, four miles east of Pendleton.
