On behalf of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation (CTUIR), we extend a warm welcome to the Epson Tour's Wildhorse Ladies Golf Classic. We're thrilled to have golfers from around the world compete on our ancestral lands, a place that has sustained our people since time immemorial. We welcome you to experience this historic ground through the game of golf.

The CTUIR is comprised of the Weyíiletpuu (Cayuse people), Imatalamłáma (Umatilla people), and Walúulapam (Walla Walla people) with more than 3,200 tribal members. Nearly half of them live on or near the Umatilla Indian Reservation, which is about 172,000 acres. In 1855, the three tribes signed a treaty with the U.S. government, in which it ceded more than 6.4 million acres. The tribes reserved rights to fish, hunt, and gather foods and medicines such as roots and berries, as well as pasture livestock on unclaimed lands. Tribal members continue to exercise these rights today.

Wildhorse Resort & Casino is a tribal enterprise, established under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act of 1988. The CTUIR leverages gaming revenue for the advancement of our people and communities, investing in vital areas such as education, cultural preservation, infrastructure, and healthcare.

By supporting the Wildhorse Resort & Casino, you're not just enjoying world-class gaming and amenities, you're also contributing to the well-being of our people and local communities.

Beyond the golf course, take time to explore our resort's many offerings. Relax in our hotel, enjoy a delicious meal, or delve into the fascinating exhibits at the Tamástslikt Cultural Institute, which offers a Native perspective on the region's history.



SPECTATOR TIPS



NEED HELP? ASK ME!

The Tournament Committee and Volunteer Chair welcome you! We hope you enjoy watching world-class golf at its best.

If you have a question simply look for a tournament volunteer with the badge shown here. We are happy to assist you.

TIPS WHEN VIEWING PLAYERS AT A HOLE OR WHEN FOLLOWING A GROUP OF PLAYERS ON THE COURSE

- Players will arrive at the course about one hour before teeing off. You can view them warming up on the driving range and putting areas.
- The first wave of tee times will start on Friday and Saturday at 7:15am on the first and tenth tee boxes with groups of three players teeing off every eleven minutes. A second wave of tee times will begin play at roughly 12:15pm. On Championship Sunday, the top 60 players and ties, will start teeing off at 7:15am on the first hole with the leaders teeing off last.
- · While on the course, please stay off the tee boxes, fairways, greens and the native grass areas.
- Be aware of the groups playing in front, to the side or behind you.
- As you watch the tournament, keep a safe distance from the players and do not allow noise or movement that may distract the players while they are hitting a shot or putting. Do not leave the green until all the players have finished the hole.
- Marshals will be on holes to help direct spectator traffic.
- Feel free to talk to the players or ask for their autographs after they have finished their round and left the scoring area.


IN THE EVENT PLAY IS SUSPENDED. YOU WILL HEAR THE FOLLOWING:

- Three consecutive blasts, repeated, this indicates a non-dangerous situation.
- One long blast, repeated, indicates a dangerous situation. At that time, Tournament Officials will direct you to a shelter or low lying area off the course. Do not remain in high places or around hill tops and or trees.
- Two long blasts means play will be resuming.

Can you hear me now?

Talking on cell phones is not permitted on the golf course; phones should be turned off or set to vibrate. There is no communication between spectators and players during the round.

· You've got to move it, move it!

To properly follow a player, follow at least 25 yards behind the group and stay near the rough or cart paths (stay clear of fairways, greens and tee boxes).

Shhhhhh...

Remain quiet and stand still while players are hitting.

Don't touch that ball, ever!

Watch the ball, stay out of its way as it lands.

· Cheer, don't jeer.

As a rule, crowds at tournaments cheer in appreciation of players' efforts. Jeering has no place in the game.

No professional photography.

Professional cameras and drones are not permitted on the course, unless by authorized personnel.
